



John 9:1-7

Jesus encounters a man blind from birth.

Who sinned? Man or parents? Jesus heals him.

This man's faith will increase rapidly.



John 9:8-12

Neighbors question the man.

"A man called Jesus" (11).

He doesn't yet know who Jesus is.



John 9:13-34

The man is questioned by Pharisees. "He is a prophet" (17).

His parents are questioned and fear expulsion from the synagogue.

"Give God the glory." A way to put a man under oath to tell the truth.



John 9:13-34

"One thing I know: that though I was blind, now I see" (25).

"Do you also want to become His disciples?" (27).

"If this man were not from God, He could do nothing" (33).

The man is then cast out, either a ONE temp. or perm. ban. THING

John 9:35-38

Jesus encounters him again.

"Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?" (36).

"Lord, I believe!" (38).

Will our faith today grow in the face of inquiry, persecution and ridicule?
