Be Ready to Preach the Word

Paul told Timothy to preach the word, be ready in season and out of season, and to reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. I know Timothy lived in a special era of Spirit inspiration as he helped to lead the church in Ephesus, establishing Elders and deacons, reaching lost souls in Ephesus, and meeting the needs of the Christians in that area. But I also believe we can glean from the instruction Paul gave and use it in each of our individual walks of faith.

We must be ready to preach the word. "The word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give an account." (Hebrews 4:12–13) Sometimes I think people hesitate to open the Word in fear that it will expose their true colors to God and then to themselves. But the Word is of the utmost importance! It "is breathed out by God and is profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16–17) If we believe this to be the case, it must become our focus in study, daily reading, and continual digestion of thought. Some people aren't ready to preach the word because they are not in the word. When they aren't in the word, they aren't focusing on God's word. If there is no focus on God's word, there will not be an everpresent thought of God's word. If there is no ever-present thought of God's word, then of course they won't be sharing it with anyone because they haven't even begun to share it with themselves! Do you see the progression?

Therefore, I would like to reprove those who need it today (2 Timothy 4:2). Reprove means to admonish. I admonish all those guilty of not being ready to preach the word to get ready by being in the Word of God daily. I would like to rebuke all of those who are guilty (2 Timothy 4:2). Rebuke means to express sharp disagreement with someone's actions. If your daily walk is void of the Word, then change must happen. But I also want to exhort (2 Timothy 4:2). There is no greater journey, task, and ascent than that of growing in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18). It is the greatest book ever written. God's nature is continually being revealed through the pages of the Scriptures. Coming to know God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the activity of the Holy Spirit more and more should be the delight and joy of every Christian's life. You are missing out, and oh how I know your love can grow!


