Do We Fellowship with That Church?

Have you been around a Christian who accepts any and every belief? The odd thing about this type of an individual is that their work often divides churches they are a part of in hopes of uniting with others. Have you been around a Christian who quickly looks to divide and draw lines, seeking to find the false teachings/teachers? The odd thing here is they normally cannot fellowship with anyone but themselves and eventually work themselves out of fellowship with all church groups! Consider 5 Degrees of Fellowship:

- 1. Universal Fellowship: Humanity. We are all created by God and therefore children on God, in one sense. In a spiritual sense, those who are outside of Christ are not children of God and have not been adopted as his children. Therefore, as we are all created beings, we are physical children of God.
- 2. Faith Fellowship: Believe in God and Christ as Lord. There are so many religious groups out there that believe in God and "submit" to Christ as Lord. While we differ on doctrinal stances and certain Bible teachings, I can appreciate these individuals in their love for God and "submission" to Christ as Lord. However, just because someone is believes in God does not make them an obedient child who has followed the pattern of sound words (2 Tim 1:13). Consider Mark 9:38–41, which says, "For the one who is not against us is for us" and Mark 12:28–34, which says, "Not far from the kingdom of God." It is possible to be close, but not a part.
- 3. In-Christ Fellowship: Christians (a.k.a. born-again, believer's baptism). Originally created to live in relationship with God, every person in right mind has (or will at some point in their life) left the innocence of childhood and sinned, resulting in alienation from God (Romans 3:23). The consequence of sin is separation from God and the result is eternal death (Romans 6:23). God's grace and eternal life are available to all who will accept Jesus Christ on His terms and will live their lives in obedience to His will (Hebrews 5:9). The salvation of humanity is dependent on God's grace and is not the result of human work or effort (Ephesians 2:8-9). Rather, our good work and good conduct is our way of pleasing God and is the recognition and result of His grace to us (2 Corinthians 5:8-9; 1 John 4:19). Each person may receive salvation by forgiveness of their own sins as the individual is immersed in baptism in Jesus' name (Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:1-7; Galatians 3:27; 1 Peter 3:21). Those who faithfully follow and are obedient to Christ are promised eternal life in Him (1 John 1:7; Revelation 2:10). And just a quick reminder—Baptism is the Doorway of God's Adoption. There is a difference in "baptism for obedience as I've already become a Christian" versus "baptism for the forgiveness of sins so God can make me a Christian".
- 4. Congregation Fellowship: within your individual church family.
- **5.** Conscience Fellowship: agree with on matters of opinion. This area normally consists of one person.
