# Why Did God Create Me Knowing...

"Let not one say when he is tempted, 'I am tempted by God'; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death." James 1:13–15

God cannot be tempted by evil. Perfection is His nature and therefore He knows what is good and right and true. It is also the case that He is fully aware of the pitfalls and problems that come as consequence of the sins we choose to commit. Think about this: He doesn't have a nature to "rise above" as His nature is perfectly pure and free of any fleshly craving. Can you imagine that? We are born, born in flesh and bound by our flesh (*Romans 7:18*). Each of us with sound mind have the capability to sin and eventually realize that potential in committing sin. Can you imagine not being pulled and enticed? Not having to fight, scratch, and claw to avoid giving in to the temptations around us? Not having to splice the emotions and desires that Satan toys and tempts us with. That would be so nice. Wouldn't it?

I have a question for you to consider...why did God do this to us anyway? James 1:15 tells us that we are "lured and enticed by our own desires." This language is that of dragging away which create a word picture of fishing. Douglas J. Moo said, "Like bait on a hook, sin tempts people and then drags them away." It has been said to me from certain individuals that they are mad at God because He created them without their consent and now must suffer daily and lifelong battles against temptations and the avoidance of sin (and, of course, the fight for and pursuit of His righteousness). So did God in fact do this to us?

The short answer is no. God did not create mankind this way. Adam and Eve were created perfect and without sin. It was their free-will choice that brought sin into the world (*Romans 5:12–21*). So why did God create me knowing that I would, by my free-will, eventually have this struggle? I need to answer this question with another question—Why do we enjoy the pleasure and ease of our sin more than the pursuit of holiness of a life in Christ? It seems to me that people looking to blame God for creating them without their own consent (*which is an impossibility*) is an attempted escape from personal responsibility to rise above and pursue the higher and better things God offers in this life. I cannot understand all things pertaining to existence and creation, why God did this or that (*Isaiah 55:8–9*). But I do know that He is working all things for my good, and part of that is the struggle against sin and the pursuit of His righteousness.
