THANKS-giving

The Old Testament word for "thanks" is used in various ways, ways we would probably not recognize. The International Standard Bible Encyclopedia says, "The Old Testament has no independent concept of 'thanks' as distinguished from 'praise'...Moreover, it never has a human being as its object." Examining this word gets us closer to the heart of what it means to be thankful, and to thank God properly during this Thanksgiving Season. Consider the following two columns of "thanks":

How We Use "THANKS" How the Bible Uses "THANKS"

You gave something to me, thank you. "I will praise the Lord" (Gen 29:35)

You were kind to me, thank you. "if they confess their iniquity..." (Lev 26:40)

You did something for me, thank you. "O give thanks to the Lord" (1 Chron 16:8)

It is not improper to thank a person for who they are or something they have done. The point I am attempting to make clear is this, thanks to God must be first, foremost, and fill up the majority of our lives. Just consider all of the blessings of God in Christ Jesus our Lord! So, as in the Scriptures, give thanks. Thanks is praise in worship and admiration being expressed to God. Thanks is confession of guilt and sin before God, and I thank God because the consequences of my sins have been paid for. Thanks is a joyful thanksgiving for God's mercy and deliverance.

Thanks, in the Scriptures, is potentially more than you would have thought it would be. So during this season, give thanks. But give thanks in the deeper, spiritual sense of the word where God is centerpiece of all our thanksgiving.
